The NSP Board of Directors is seeking an NSP member to serve as the National Alumni Program Coordinator to formulate and implement an expanded national Alumni program. The person may be an active patroller or an alumnus with substantial NSP experience. It is desirable that he or she should have knowledge of the present Alumni Program and should have served in a position above the patrol level in order to be familiar with the NSP Policies and Procedures and the NSP administrative processes. A resume of NSP and professional experience is requested.

Most important, he or she should be a proactive self-starter committed to organizing and maintaining an alumni program at the national level that provides value to the NSP and its alumni members. The person chosen should have a demonstrated ability to work well with a variety of personalities and temperaments. He or she should possess administrative skills to conduct a robust program through the Division Alumni Administrators and leaders of additional subunits. The program coordinator should have sufficient time and energy to devote to and complete the necessary tasks.

National Alumni Program Coordinator is appointed by the National Chair and is confirmed by the National Board of Directors.
