

EASTERN DIVISION SKI AND TOBOGGAN STAFF DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

A senior alpine patroller who exhibits strong skiing/riding and toboggan skills on more difficult terrain, varying conditions and weather, has completed instructor development (Phase II, S&T), is a current Toboggan Instructor and has successfully passed the trainer evaluator clinic evaluation is eligible for nomination to the Eastern Division S&T Staff.

The patroller must demonstrate outstanding leadership, good character, a positive attitude for training and evaluation with good judgment. Should lead by example and motivate candidates in all aspects of the ski and toboggan programs by promoting continued self improvement; should provide a non-threatening atmosphere for training and effective feedback. Assist with the delivery of S&T programs at the region and local level to support mountain management. Conduct senior training clinics, senior evaluations and the enhancement programs; complete administrative requirements for course completion and as required by policy and procedure.

Identify, develop and mentor trainer evaluators and prospective trainer evaluator candidates

Staff members are appointed by the Ski and Toboggan Supervisor with the consultation of their S&T Region Advisor. The size and make-up of division staff is based on need, geographic population and the ability to effectively provide program delivery at all levels within the division. Appointments to the Eastern Division Ski and Toboggan staff are renewable yearly.

The primary focus of Eastern Division Staff is to promote the senior alpine ski and toboggan program within all areas of training and to enhance the skills necessary to maintain proficiency at the local and region programs. Quality assurance programs are also the responsibility of division staff.
