- Scope of training: Skills and toboggan handling
- Responsibility: Candidate training and annual toboggan sign-off
- Requirement: Complete Instructor Development course and apprenticed by a TE
- Refresh: Complete STW, TTW or OETIC every 3 yrs

- Skill Level: 7
- Geography: Region
- Scope of training: Riding, Skills and toboggan handling
- Responsibility: TI + Senior training and examination
- Requirement: Senior + TI, apprenticed by RA/IT/Staff and pass TE certification
- Refresh: Complete TE recertification, which includes STW, TTW and OETIC every 3 yrs

- Skill Level: 7+
- Geography: Region/Division
- Scope of training: Riding, Skills and toboggan handling + train the trainer
- Responsibility: Instructor of Record, TE training and Senior exam QA + other duties
- Requirement: TE + experience, appointed by OET Supervisor
- Refresh: Maintain TE certification and renewed by OET Supervisor

Toboggan Instructor (TI)

Instructor Trainer (IT) / Staff

NSP Registered Courses: Ski Trainer Workshop (STW), Toboggan Trainer Workshop (TTW), and OET Instructor Continuing-Education (OETIC or ICE)



Regional Advisor (RA): An RA leads the OET senior program and training for a region and must be a TE (and may also be an IT)
