



## Division guidelines for Applying to become an Outdoor Emergency Transportation (OET) Trainer Evaluator (TE)

These requirements are intended to insure that OET Instructors or Toboggan Instructors (TI) have prepared sufficiently to become an OET TE and are ready to be successful at a TE Evaluation.

- 1) Must be a Senior or higher level Patroller
- 2) Must be an “active” OET Instructor / TI for a period of at least 1 year.
- 3) Must have the approval of the OET Regional Administrator (RA)
- 4) Must shadow the OET Regional staff for at least 1 year. A minimum of 5 events is recommended.
- 5) Must attend a division sponsored TE Evaluation at a Patroller School or equivalent as a TE candidate.
- 6) Must be “signed off” by an OET Instructor Trainer (IT) Assigned to the TE Evaluation
